UNION CENTER CEMETERY

Located in SW cor. of Sect. 10, Twp. 29S Rge 24E

This is 3 mi E and 1 mi N of the E edge of Girard. A driveway enters at the middle of the S end, over the arched gateway: "Union Center". This drive goes to the N end and exits at the NW cor. There are few graves in the $N\frac{1}{2}$, except along the center drive. There are 10 rows of graves to the W and 10 to the E of this center drive.

The 1906 atlas shows the Brisbin farm as "J. C. Brisbin 158 acres", while the other three quarter sections each contain 160 acres each, so apparently the original cemetery was 2 acres in extent.

Mrs. L. G. Brisbin of Girard who has owned the $SW\frac{1}{4}$ for many years, once lived in a house a short distance E of this cem. She states the original size was 2 acres. Probably about 1905 the cemetery association bought 2 more acres directly N of the original plot. This part has few burials except along the center drive. The mother of Mr. Brisbin and children were buried there, but later removed to the Girard cem.

Mrs. Brisbin states the Union Center Church of God was the name of the church that once stood on the SW cor. of this intersection, which would place it on the NE cor of Sect. 16. It was a large church, and had a large Sunday School room. She recalled that Mrs. T. L. McWilliams was Sunday School Supt. for many years. The minister, and his wife was also a minister, came from Mulberry, where there was another Church of God. Later a Mrs. Renfro from Dutch Valley preached here. Regular services were discontinued, perhaps about 1908.

Miss Elva Duff, who was once on the cemetery board with Meigs Ellison and Ben Louderback, told us the Girard Grange has just now taken over the care of this cem., although they have helped for some years. The township gives them \$100 per year to help with expenses. Charlie Nye and Sam Campbell, Grange members, assist with this work.

Both Mrs. Brisbin and Miss Duff believed the cemetery was started before the church and was not a cemetery of the church.

The oldest death date found: p. 9 Nelson Talley born Feb 20 1824 died May 22 1871

The oldest birth date found: p. 11 Ganne Pelochoud died June 16 1882 aged 85 years.

Mrs. Ethel Andrew (nee Gregg) of Girard stated 9-1972 that her uncle Webb Gregg was the first to own the farm where the cem. is located. He later returned to Iowa.

Records in the Register Of Deeds Office at Girard Kansas show that the K.C.F.S.&G. R.R. sold the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ to N. W. Gregg 6-10-1880. However, the M.R.F.S.&G. RR sold the original cem. site to the Trustees of Union Burying Ground, Washington Twp, Crawford Co. Ks. 10-20-1875 for \$18. (Book D p. 365) Commending at SW cor of Section, E 18 rods, N 16, W 18, S 18 containing 2 acres & $\frac{1}{4}$ rods more or less.

John C. Brisbin became the owner of the farm 3-4-1895, his dau.-in-law is still the owner. He sold on 16-18-1910 to the Trustees of Union Burying Ground (Book 74 p. 292) the north part of the present cem., beginning 18 rods N of SW cor of section, E 18, N $17\frac{3}{4}$, W 18, S $17\frac{3}{4}$, containing 2 acres more or less, for \$100.

Someone told us Fred Hough (pronounced Huff) carved an old rock for wife's grave (p. 9), this apparently was replaced by the double headstone.

Mrs. Max E. Alumbaugh of Quincy Wash. (1972) said the infant son of C. T. & L.M. Alumbaugh bur. 1st row E of center drive was Charles Lee Alumbaugh, son of Charley Tisdale Alumbaugh and Laura May (Neely). However, family records showed b & d 1904.
