CHEROKEE CEMETERY

Located NW cor of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 7, Twp. 31S. Rge 24E.

This is on the E side of highway #7 about 1 mi N of Cherokee. A gravel road on the half-mile line runs along the N side of the cem., and there are four entrances from this gravel road into the cem.; the entrance from Highway #7 at the SW corner having been closed for several years.

The cem. is well-kept, except where old curbing interferes with mowing. The approximate size is 400' N-S and 1300' E-W. It is divided into 20 sections by roadways. The oldest part is in the middle, with a later addition to the W and still later an addition to the E.

THE MIDDLE SECTION was the original part. A copy of the original plat dated 4-1-1914, many years after it was platted, showed that it began 620' E & 20' S of NW cor. of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 7-31-24; S (by 2° 40' E of S) 365'; W** 252'; N (angled) 365'; E** to beginning.
 ***Note error in description of orig. plat; boundary should go 365' S as stated; then 252' E (not W); N 365' as stated; then W (not E) to beginning.

The lots in the orig. plat were 10' E-W and 21' N-S. A notation states that the orig. plat shows space 21' wide & 252' long along N side as occupied by 2-20' & 1-12' roadway extending across to N line, & 20 lots numbered 2 to 20 both inclusive. The two sections in the original plat were not numbered, the lots being numbered 1 to 322 inclusive, beginning at NE cor. to W, then next row S from W to E, etc., across the 2 sections. No plat was found in the County Register of Deeds office, but the City Clerk of Cherokee had one recently found and presented to the city by Mrs. Grace Deill Harvey.

THE WEST SECTION was the FIRST ADDITION, dated Aug 1889, plat filed 7-14-1890, beginning at NW cor of orig. Cherokee cem., W 612' to NW cor of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sect. 7-31-24, S 404', E 612', N 404' to beginning. This plat and that of 2nd add. were found in County Register of Deeds office, Girard, Kansas.

THE EAST SECTION was the SECOND ADDITION, surveyed 6-1909, replatted 5-31-1913, dedicated 6-3-1913, D.A. Iliff, mayor. Beginning 872' E of NW cor of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 7 E 444.5', S 404', W 401', N(angled) 404.8' to place of beginning.

9-15-1971 Mr. Jack Major, caretaker of the Cherokee cem. for the past few months, stated that old residents of the community had told him that some years ago when graves were dug in the E part (2nd add.) two old negro slave graves were found, which were not marked, and apparently predated the cem. It is also believed there are 2 more in the W part (1st add.) but location is not known; likely they are in the vicinity of sections 8 or 9 (my numbering, not official section numbers; see map)

Mrs. Emma Rupard could recall many years ago when there was a house where the E part (2nd add.) is now located.

The numbers given to the 20 sections of this cem. show the order in which they were copied for this record, and are in no way official numbers.

CHEROKEE CEMETERY NOTES

4-5-1974 Miss Elaine Holstine of Pittsburg, Kans., has grandparents, Hugh and Jane Reid, buried in Cherokee Cem. She states that her grandfather, Hugh Reid (1846-1936) told that Willie Manlove, a child buried next to their lot (see p.16) was the first burial in the cemetery. He was not related to them, but Elaine puts flowers on his grave each Memorial Day. The Manlove stone shows date of death as 9-9-1871. Four other stones in this cemetery show earlier dates of death, but it is likely they were moved in at a later date.

The 1905 History of Crawford County, Kans., p. 28: "The first child born in the town (Cherokee) was Willie Manlove, who lived but a short time, and his funeral was the occasion of the first sermon preached in the town, and his burial was the first in the now beautiful cemetery, the location of which was made by Capt. Jameson and J. F. Price."

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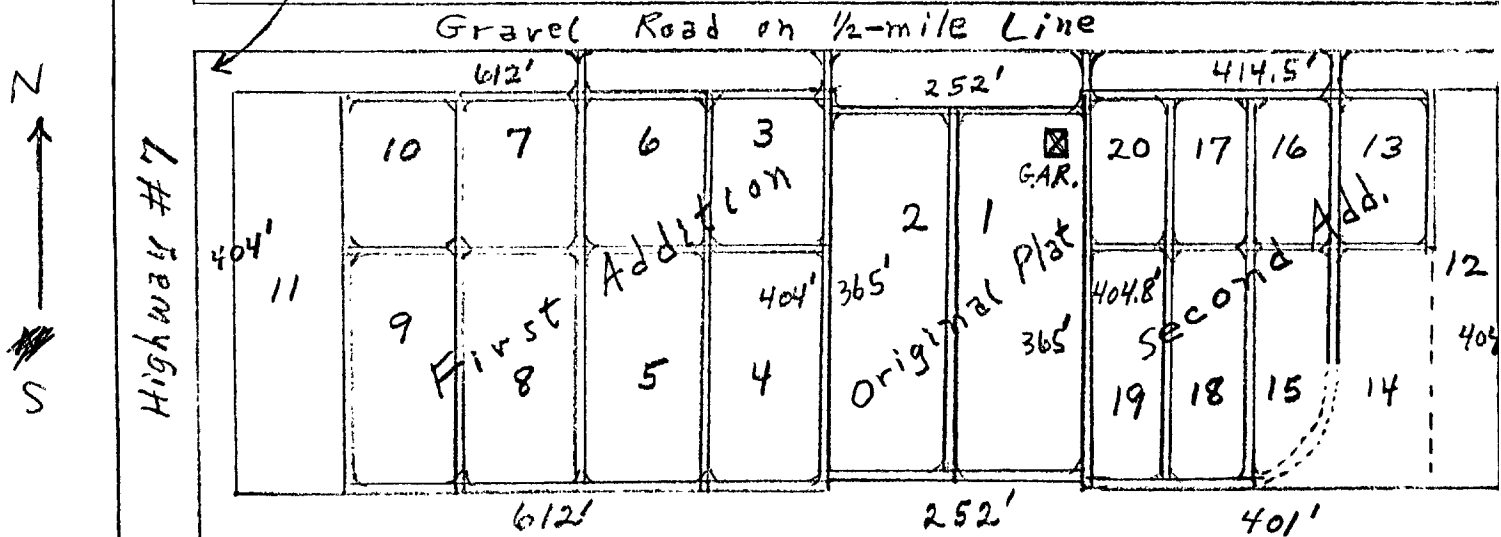


