FARLINGTON KANSAS CEMETERY

The Farlington Cemetery is located on the west side of state highway #7 (an original county road) 3/4 mile north of the Farlington corner, which places it along the east side of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 12 Twp 28S rge 23E Crawford County, Kansas.

The cemetery has an iron gateway with "Farlington Cemetery" arched above. The central road west into the cemetery is paved with brick and divides the cemetery into a north half and a south half, ending at a brick tool shed where there is a N-S driveway crossing the cemetery. Another N-S driveway about half way back to the tool shed divides this older part of the cemetery into 4 sections, 2 on the north and 2 on the south of the central drive. From the tool shed on west is a newer part, not divided by any central road. We copied the 5 sections in this order:

First section on north (NE corner)
 Second section on north (middle N part)
 First section on south (SE corner)
 Second section on south (middle S part)
 West addition, full width of cemetery, west of tool house

There is timber to the north and south of the cemetery, and some to the west, the entire square mile was once a tree farm owned by the railroad. The cemetery is located high on a rounding hill with excellent views to the east and west. It appears to be well mowed and maintained and has many newer graves, with much room to expand to the west.

The oldest death date mentioned is found on p. 16: "In memory of Granny Horney and Granny Hudson Pioneer Mothers died 1872. Lettie J. Crites. donor". It does not state whether they are buried here. On p. 15 & 16 are 5 stones of deaths during the year 1875. We noted no earlier dates, but some of the older stones are illegible or set too deeply to read the dates.

(Further notes added 11-20-1970: Glenn Noel of Girard, formerly of Farlington recalled that Jim Farley was the first postmaster of Farlington, and the town was named for him. The first grave in the Farlington Cemetery was that of his son Willie, who was probably about 12 years old. The boy had gone out S $\frac{1}{2}$ of town to check a herd of about 18 cows, riding his pony, and his dog following. The pony came back, but not the boy or the dog. A search was made and the boy's body was found, the dog having stayed with him. A doctor from Girard was called and an examination made, and it was decided that death was due to natural causes, there being no injuries evident. Grandma Swan knew the location of this first grave, which was unmarked, and after her death no one knows for certain the exact location.)

Note: Wm. Lawler, pres. of the Farlington Cem. Assn. stated 6-9-1884 that said corporation owned the cem. in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 12-28-23, this info. was on the cem. plat in the Register of Deeds office, Crawford Co. Ks.

The drives were named as follows: E-W drives from N to S: North Street, Central Ave., South Street; N-S drives from E to W: East Avenue, Division Ave., and W. Avenue.
