FRONTENAC CITY CEMETERY
Frontenac, Kans.

Located NW cor. of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 9, Twp. 30 S., Rge. 25 E.

This is on the S side of the public road, $\frac{1}{2}$ mi E of Frontenac, Kans. the K.C. Southern R.R. forms the SE boundary.

The cem. consists of 3 sections adjacent to the road (which we labeled West, Middle and East) divided by driveways and a drive running E-W just S of these 3 sections. South of this drive are some graves at the E end, which appear older than the 3 N. Sections, and a few graves at the W end. Perhaps 150' S along the W side is one lone grave, that of Friedrich Bozic b & d 1904, the oldest burial found (p. 16). The oldest burial in the SE part is Stefano Delladio 1899-1907 (p. 13) and the oldest b date in this SE part is Rutilio Mangoni 1850-1913 (p. 14). The oldest burial in the 3 N sections is in the W section, that of Joseph Louis Fotheringill 1910-1910 (p. 6). The oldest b. date in the cem. is Mary E. LeRoy 1835-1924 (p. 7), found in the Middle section.

1-25-1973 Frank Bozich 306 S. Jefferson, Frontenac, didn't know of the Bozic infant's grave, but believed it could be a child of his uncle John who married 3 or 4 times. The stone states: "Friedrick son of J. & M. Bozic born & died June 8 1904 Bozic".

3-15-1973 Mr. John C. Friskel of the Friskel Funeral Home at Frontenac has been in business there since 1910, and an undertaker since April 1913, 60 years ago, and is quite familiar with the community. He believes there are several graves in the extreme south point of the cem., at least 2 at the point, and possibly others in that general area which are not marked. He believed one was a veteran, probably of the Civil or Spanish American War. Mr. Friskel believed the entire cem. was laid out into lots, possibly explaining the great distance between the 3 earliest graves found. The only maps known are of 2 sections along the road, drawn in 1965 by the Friskels. It is not known what became of the original maps. (The City Clerk had no map.) Mr. Friskel believed many people in this community used the Pittsburg Cemeteries before these were established about the turn of the century. The larger Catholic Cem. corners to the NW, across the road from this city cemetery.

The Register of Deeds office of Crawford Co., Kans., has no plat of either Frontenac Cemetery.
