MESSAGES FROM APPOINTED OFFICIALS NEW BUSINESS

Item One: County Counselor Jim Emerson discussed the Kansas Homeowners Assistance Fund (KHAF) through the Kansas Housing Resources Corporation. He stated that there is \$57,000,000 allocated to the State of Kansas and it will assist homeowners in paying delinquent mortgage payments, property taxes and utilities along with other fees. He explained the assistance terms, qualifications and income guidelines of the program. Mr. Emerson stated that 20 applications have been submitted from Crawford County with 16 applications in progress and 1 application approved. He explained how to apply for the program and a stated that this information will be posted on the county website.

Item Two: Mr. Emerson stated that EMS Director Randy Sandberg and EMS Administrator Dr. Tim Stebbins have requested a budget work session for the EMS Department on June 14, 2022 at 9:00 AM. The Commissioners agreed.

Item Three: Mr. Emerson presented a Notice of Intent to Vacate Platted Alleys in the Original Town of Englevale, Crawford County, Kansas. He showed a map of the area and explained where the proposed alleys are located. He stated that there is only one property owner involved in this request. He explained that the Notice of Intent will be published this Friday with a public hearing date set for June 17, 2022 at 10:00 AM in the County Commission Room.

On motion (22-183) of Commissioner Blair and the second of Commissioner Moody to approve publication of the Notice to Vacate Platted Alleys in the Original Town of Englevale, Crawford County, Kansas with a public hearing set for June 17, 2022 at 10:00 AM in the County Commission Room.
