The Crawford County Board of Commissioners met pursuant to Kansas Statutes Annotated Chapter 19, Article 2, Section 18 in due and regular session with open doors. Commissioner Tom Moody served as the presiding officer.

Commissioner Carl Wood was in attendance.

County Clerk Don Pyle and County Counselor Jim Emerson were seated with the Board.

Vice Chairman Moody led the pledge of allegiance.

MESSAGES FROM THE PUBLIC

Item One: Mr. David Pearson addressed the Commissioners with 911 Service questions. Mr. Pearson stated that he lives at 1158 N 140th St, Fort Scott, Kansas which is in Crawford County. He explained how the area has changed mailing addresses over the

years and now the mailing service is out of Fort Scott. He stated that his wife was involved in an automobile accident 2 weeks ago at the intersection of 140th St and 720th Ave in Crawford County. Mr. Pearson explained the events that followed after his wife called 911. He stated that the 911 dispatcher stated that Crawford County did not have a deputy available and the dispatcher stated that she had contacted the Highway Patrol out of Bourbon County. Mr. Pearson stated that the Highway Patrol officer could not locate the intersection of the accident and it took an hour and a half for the officer to appear. He stated that his wife did not any major injuries but is concerned with the response time if there was an emergency. The Commissioners stated that Sheriff Peak will be notified of his concerns.
